



## Regular Household Waste

- 35 gallon container
- Maximum 50 lbs. as regulated by OSHA
- Bulk items and white goods may be placed curbside on weekly collection day

## Recyclables

- 18 gallon bin or 35 gallon container clearly marked "RECYCLING"
- Recycling Stickers have been provided to the Village of New Haven
- Maximum 50 lbs. as regulated by OSHA
- **ABSOLUTELY NO PLASTIC BAGS** - neither clear nor opaque - plastic bags are a contaminant at the Material Recovery Facility and cause equipment damage and lost productivity, adding to the cost to recycle <https://vimeo.com/170817933?lite=1>

  - CARDBOARD - broken down and flattened, no staples or plastic bands, NO pizza boxes soiled with food
  - GLASS - clear and colored - **empty** (no liquids)
  - PLASTIC CONTAINERS - **empty** - (no liquids)  
ONLY #'s 1, 2, 4, 5 & 7 - **NO 3 or 6** accepted at this time
  - Metals (aluminum and steel cans) - **empty** (no liquids) labels are o.k.
  - Cartons - **empty**
